Riddle

Question: A 100% Orthodox conversion is performed and only milah (for a male) and tevila are required, but kabbalat haMitzvot (acceptance of the Mitzvot) is not required. How is this possible?

Last Week's Riddle:

Question: We normally begin saying "v'ten tal u'matar livracha" at Maariv on Dec. 4 (eve of Dec. 5), and in a December before a year with Feb. 29, at Maariv on Dec. 5 (eve of Dec. 6). This December does not precede a Feb. 29, and yet we will begin saying "v'ten ..." at Maariv on December 5. Do you know why?

Answer: This year, December 4 Maariv is Friday night (Shabbos), so the first opportunity to say "v'ten ..." after that is at Maariv after Shabbos on Dec. 5.
