**Question:** When we "bentch" Rosh Chodesh once a month, we ask Hashem for long life in the y'hi ratzon prayer. But there is another prayer in which we explicitly ask for long life, and that prayer is said a minimum of four times a week. Do you know what it is?

**Answer:** In Brich Sh'meh, the paragraph said in shul when we take the Torah out of the Aron, we say (in Aramaic) "Yehai ra'ava kadamach d'torich lan chayin b'tivuta" which translates to "May it be Your will to grant us long life with goodness."
