Last Week's Riddle:

Question: Fruit in Israel that buds after Tu B'Shvat is subject to the appropriate ma'aser of that year (ma'aser sheni in years 1, 2, 4, 5 of the shmitta cycle, ma'aser ani in years 3 and 6), and the ma'aser of the previous year if it buds before Tu B'Shvat, even if it is picked afterwards. There is ONE exception. The ma'aser type of what fruit is determined by when it is picked (before or after Tu B'Shvat) and not by when it buds?

Answer: The etrog. See Mishna Bikkurim 2:6.

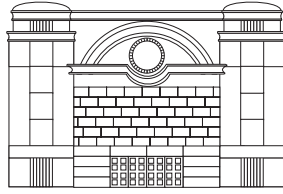
