**Question:** Can you find a Jewish Star on a U.S. one dollar bill? It was placed there intentionally. Do you know why, and who suggested it?

**Answer:** The stars inside the cloud above the eagle on the back of the bill form a Jewish Star. George Washington had it inserted on the Great Seal of the U.S. to honor Haym Solomon (also spelled Salomon), who helped finance the Revolutionary War. Solomon lived only 45 years and died in 1785 in poverty.

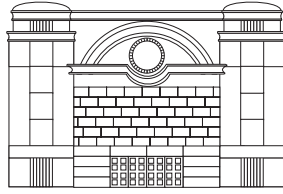
